07' Nobel Peace Prize Recipient John Byrne to Speak at
Renewable Energy Fair Scheduled for April 18th

Rehoboth, Delaware April 03, 2009: Delaware Renewable Energy Company of Rehoboth Beach is honored to welcome John Byrne to the 2nd Annual Renewable Energy Fair, scheduled for Saturday, April 18th from 10a.m. – 2p.m. at the Baycenter in Dewey Beach.

Byrne is the Director of the Center for Energy and Environmental Policy (CEEP) at the University of Delaware and recipient of the 2007 Nobel Peace Prize, which he shares with former Vice President Al Gore for promoting the understanding of climate change issues. Byrne has been a contributing author to the United Nations sponsored Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change since 1992.

Dr. Byrne presently co-chairs the Sustainable Energy Utility Oversight Board, and is the architect of this innovative concept for the promotion of energy efficiency, conservation, and distributed renewable energy generation.

His most recent book is *Transforming Power*, which explores the prospects for significant changes in the world energy system in order to reverse human-induced climate change. He has published 17 books and over 150 research articles.

Dr. Byrne will be a guest presenter at Delaware Renewable Energy Company's 2nd Annual Renewable Energy Fair. He is pleased to be speaking at the fair, "I think it is critical to the future of Delaware that all of our citizens understand the opportunities for moving to a new era of sustainable energy. We can all make practical energy decisions for a green economy and healthy planet. But we must act quickly."
